You will be taking your test on computer. You will need to make sure that your headphones are plugged in properly and working.

**Let them know how to adjust volume on your computers at this point.

The test will ask for your name and school name. Please enter your full name and name of your school and click next.

**In the following instructions, the first number will be for $3^{rd}/4^{th}$ grade, the second number for $5^{th}/6^{th}$, and the third for $7^{th}/8^{th}$.

The test consists of (50, 80, 110) words. The words are pronounced automatically, but you can hear them again by clicking on the Replay button. For each word, there is a brief definition. Type the word in the box at the bottom. Please note that you can see the definition for a word only one time. Once you leave a word, the definition will not be displayed if you return to that word; however, the word will be pronounced as many times as you need to hear it.

On the official list, some words have alternate spellings. On this test be sure <u>to enter only one</u> <u>correct spelling</u> even if the official list includes an alternate; do not enter both spellings.

In some instances, the official list includes clarifications after words. In your answer, <u>submit only the spelling word</u> and do not include any descriptions such as (singular), (verb), etc.

If a special character is required to spell a word, just click the needed character on the set of characters that is above the blank. You may go back and check or change any word on the test before you click to go on to the Tie Breaker; however once you have started the Tie Breaker, you may not return to this test.

Please note that you can see the definition for a word only one time. Once you leave a word, the definition will not be displayed if you return to that word; however, the word will be pronounced.

You have (16, 20, 26) minutes to complete this portion of the test.

The Tie Breaker consists of (15, 20, 30) words. It will operate in the same manner as the main portion of the test.

You have (6, 7, 9) minutes to complete the Tie Breaker.

When you have finished, your work will be graded and printed.

**At this point you can have them raise their hand for permission to print at the end of the test or tell them to click next when they are ready to print on the final screen
